

Lenten Season Events for St. Paul

- 1) Starting Friday, February 26-Stations of the Cross
 - a. Stations will take place in the Church at 5:30 throughout the Lenten season.
 - b. Please note that we will not be doing Stations this Friday, February 19th due to weather.
- 2) Starting Monday, February 29—Adoration
 - a. We will have adoration in the church from 8-12 on Mondays.
 - b. Please sign-up in the back of the church to fill all the times.
 - c. I do ask everyone to enter through the chapel to the church for adoration
 - d. I know many work during the day so will not be able to sign-up. I do encourage everyone to take advantage of our chapel to pray during the Lenten season.
- 3) Parish Mission
 - a. Starting Sunday, March 21st through March 23rd we will be having our parish mission given by Fr. Scott Thomas from St. Mary Basilica in Natchez.
 - b. The mission will occur on Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday nights at 6:00pm
 - c. Fr. Scott Thomas will be preaching Masses on the weekend of March 20-21 to introduce the mission.
- 4) Men's Reflection for Lent.
