Our goal is to start this ministry by August 1st. We want to maintain safety for all our parishioners. Please do not bring a pyx up in the communion line to receive communion to take home to a family member. We understand that people are missing receiving the Body of Christ, but for right now this is the way we are handling the current situation. We appreciate your understanding!

We ask the ushers to please watch the seating of parishioners. They may seat themselves but maintain their social distancing.
