Twelfth grade winner wins a \$1000.00 scholarship. Deadline for entries is 11/30. **Keep**

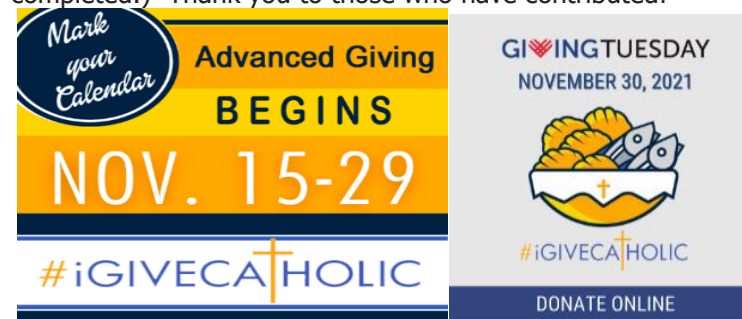
